•The Jewish mindset of prophecy is cyclical.

Example:

•The sacrifice of Isaac in Gen. 22 was a picture of what was to come through God the Father giving His only Son Jesus to be sacrificed.







HOW TO INTERPRET SCRIPTURE

•2 Peter 1:20: "Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation."





HOW TO INTERPRET SCRIPTURE

•2 Corinthians 13:1: "This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established."





WIDE VARIETY OF INTERPRETATIONS

- Highly Symbolic Language
 - Symbols → open to vastly different understandings
 - Presuppositions about Biblical Eschatology:
 - Literal: Predicts the future, the coming End of the World
 - Historical: Reflects persecutions faced by Early Christians
 - Theological: Describes timeless conflict: Good vs. Evil
- Ex: When is Millennium vis-à-vis Parousia?
 - Pre-millennialism / "Catastrophic" 1000-year reign of peace will come only after the great tribulation and the return of Jesus; believers must be prepared to endure difficult trials
 - Post-millennialism / "Progressive" 1000-year reign of peace must be established on earth by human beings and societies; Jesus will return only after that is accomplished
 - A-millennialism 1000-year reign of Rev 20 is not literal, but purely symbolic; when Jesus returns cannot be predicted

WIDE VARIETY OF INTERPRETATIONS

Pre-millennialism

> Pre-Tribulation

 Jesus removes the Church before the tribulation.

> Mid-Tribulation

 Jesus removes the Church in the middle of the tribulation.

Post-Tribulation

 Jesus removes the Church at the end of the tribulation.



THE PATMOS EXILE

- Exiled by Domitian (81-96 AD) the brother of Titus who destroyed Jerusalem in 70 AD.
- History
- Hippolytus:
- John was first plunged into a boiling oil, and then sent to this island exile
- Victorinus:
- John was forced to work in the mines that were located on Patmos
- Irenaeus, Clement, and Eusebius:
- After Domitian dies, John returned to Ephesus, went to the churches, and appointed leaders, and set things in order

Rapture: The English word "rapture" is derived from the Latin verb "Rapere" meaning "to carry off," or "to catch up."

WHAT IS THE RAPTURE?

•John14 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴ And where I go you know, and the way you know." ⁵ Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" ⁶ Iesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.



WHEN DOES THE RAPTURE OCCUR? (PRE/MID/POST ETC)

- Will the rapture happen? There are three main beliefs regarding the time frame of the Rapture
- Depend on a personal Hermeneutics (Your personal understanding of the Bible)
- Hermeneutics: the branch of knowledge that deals with interpretation, especially of the Bible or literary texts.
- Prophecy No Private Interpretation
- ¹⁹ And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; ²⁰ knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, ²¹ for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit. (2 Peter 1:19-21)

PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE:

- •The most popularly taught view among Christian faiths is known as the Pre-Tribulation Rapture, or "Pre-Trib" theory. Those who accept this perspective believe the Rapture will happen just before the tribulation period, at the beginning of the seventieth week of Daniel.
- •The Rapture will usher in the final seven years of this age. True followers of Jesus Christ will be transformed into their spiritual bodies in the Rapture and taken from the Earth to be in Heaven with God.

PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE:

Non-believers will be left behind to face severe tribulation as the antichrist prepares to take his place as the Beast half way through the seven year period. According to this view, nonbelievers will still come to accept Christ, in spite of the Church's absence during this time, however, these new Christians will endure extreme persecution, to the point of death by beheading.

- •Another popular view is known as the Post-Tribulation Rapture, or "Post-Trib" theory. Those who accept this perspective believe that Christians will remain on the Earth as witnesses during the seven year tribulation period, until the very end of this age.
- •According to this view, believers will be either removed or protected from the terrible wrath of God predicted toward the end of the seven years in the book of Revelation.

MID-TRIBULATION RAPTURE

- •A less popular view is known as the Mid-Tribulation Rapture, or "Mid-Trib" theory. Those who accept this perspective believe that Christians will be taken from the Earth to be in Heaven with God at some point during the middle of the seven year period of tribulation.
- •Mid-tribulation affirm that it is a clear teaching of Scripture that although Christians will not experience the wrath of God, believers are not exempt from tribulation in this world (Matt. 5:11-12, 10:34-35, 24:1-31; Mark 13:1-27; Luke 21:1-28; John 16:33, 17:15; James 1:2-15; 1 Pet. 4:12-19).

MID-TRIBULATION RAPTURE

- Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete. ² And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. (Rev. 15:1-2)
- The Parable of the Wheat and the Tares (Matthew 13:24-30)
- ²⁴ Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; ²⁵ but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way. ²⁶ But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared. ²⁷ So the servants of the owner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?' ²⁸ He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' The servants said to him, 'Do you want us then to go and gather them up?' ²⁹ But he said, 'No, lest while you gather up the tares you also uproot the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn.""

WHEN DOES THE PERIOD OF TRIBULATION OCCUR?

- Pre/Mid/Post Depend on a personal Hermeneutics (Your personal understanding of the Bible)
- The Tribulation is focused on the Jews and Israel
- "Turning to the Old Testament we find in Jer. 30:4-6, that it is the time of "Jacob's Trouble," and is compared in its sufferings to the "birth-pangs" of a woman. In Eze 26:34 it is spoken of as the time when-Israel shall "Pass under the Rod;" and in Eze. 22:19-21, we read how that God is going to cast Israel into His "Melting Pot," where they are to be refined as "gold is refined." See also Mal. 3:1-3, and Zech. 13:9. Daniel speaks of it as a "Time of Trouble" for his people, the Jews. Dan. 12:1.
- Detail of The Tribulation Revelation Chapters 6 to 19

WHEN DOES THE LAST SEVEN PLAGUES OCCUR?

- This occurs right before the second coming of Jesus
- It is detailed in Revelation chapter 15 and 16
- Do not confuse the Tribulation with the Last Seven Plagues
- Do not confuse the Rapture with the Second Coming of Jesus
- The Last Seven Plagues
 - First Bowl: Loathsome Sores
 - Second Bowl: The Sea Turns to Blood
 - Third Bowl: The Waters Turn to Blood
 - Fourth Bowl: Men Are Scorched
 - Fifth Bowl: Darkness and Pain
 - Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up
 - Seventh Bowl: The Earth Utterly Shaken



WHEN DOES THE LAST SEVEN PLAGUES OCCUR?

•"Immediately after the **tribulation** of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Matthew 24:29)

ARE GOD'S PEOPLE RAPTURED BEFORE THE SEVEN LAST PLAGUES?

- •Pre-Trib ² And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. (Rev. 15:2)
- •Mid-Trib ² And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. (Rev. 15:2)
- Post-Trib ¹³ each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. (1 Cor. 3:13)
- The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed. (Rev. 15:2)


TRIBULATION

- Don't confuse persecution with the specific "Great Tribulation"
- Most of the Body, in most of the world, for most of the past 1900 year
- But you have today rejected your God, who Himself saved you from all your adversities and your tribulations; and you have said to Him, 'No, set a king over us!' Now therefore, present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes and by your clans." (I Samuel 10:9)
- yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when **tribulation** or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles. (Matthew 13:21)
- "Then they will deliver you up to **tribulation** and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. (Matthew 24:9)
- strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to continue in the faith, and *saying*, "We must through many **tribulation**s enter the kingdom of God." (Acts 14:22)
- And not only *that,* but we also glory in **tribulation**s, knowing that **tribulation** produces perseverance; (Romans 5:3)



BISHOP OF SMYRNA

- Polycarp, Bishop of Smyrna
- In 166 AD, the bishop of Smyrna, Polycarp, refused to recant
- •"Eighty and six years have I served Him, and He never did me wrong. How can I now blaspheme my King who has loved me so?"
- The old man was burned at the stake on the Sabbath day, on object of Jewish hatred as well as from the Roman persecution



Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.

 3 And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast.
- His Physical Description: Zechariah 11:17

RAPTURE PRECEDES THE TRIBULATION

- 70th Week is defined by covenant enforced by the Coming World Leader – Dan. 9:27
- "Great Tribulation" = last $\frac{1}{2}$ of 70^{th} Week Matt 24:15,21
- The Leader cannot be revealed until after the Rapture 2 Thess. 2:6-9
- And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. ⁷ For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. ⁸ And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. ⁹ The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, (2 Thess. 2:6-9)





1. Every person was created a Muslim:

Quran 2:213

Mankind was [of] one religion [before their deviation]; then Allah sent the prophets as bringers of good tidings and warners and sent down with them the Scripture in truth to judge between the people concerning that in which they differed. And none differed over the Scripture except those who were given it - after the clear proofs came to them - out of jealous animosity among themselves. And Allah guided those who believed to the truth concerning that over which they had differed, by His permission. And Allah guides whom He wills to a straight path.



2. God has no Son:

Ouran 17:43

... other gods along with Allah, but He is Allah, the One, the ..., whom all creatures need. He begets not, nor was He begotten ...


3. There is no Trinity:

Quran 4:171

They do blaspheme who say: Allah is one of three in a Trinity: for there is no god except One Allah. If they desist not from their word (of blasphemy), verily a grievous penalty will befall the blasphemers among them.



4. Jesus did not die:





Among the Major Signs, the most anticipated and central sign that Muslims are awaiting is the coming of a man known as, "The Mahdi." In Arabic, al-Mahdi means, "The Guided One" ¹ He is also sometimes referred to by Shi'a Muslims as Sahib Al-Zaman or Al-Mahdi al-Muntadhar which translated mean "The Lord of the Age" and "The Guided/Awaited One." The Mahdi is the first of the Major Signs. This is confirmed by Ibn Kathir, the renowned Muslim scholar from the eighth century:

• "After the lesser signs of the Hour appear and increase, mankind will have reached a stage of great suffering. Then the awaited Mahdi will appear; He is the first of the greater clear, signs of the Hour."

Islam's Messiah A Man From The Family Of Muhammad

The "rising" of the Mahdi is to the majority of Muslims what the return of Jesus is to Christians.

- The first and most often cited Islamic belief with regard to the Mahdi is the tradition which states that the Mahdi will descend from the family of Muhammad and will bear Muhammad's name:
- The world will not come to pass until a man from among my family, whose name will be my name, rules over the Arabs. 8
- The Prophet said: The Mahdi will be of my family, of the descendants of Fatimah [Muhammad's daughter].



A Universal Leader For All Muslims

- Throughout the Islamic world today there is a call for the restoration of the Islamic Caliphate. The Caliph (*Khalifa*) in Islam may be viewed somewhat as the Pope of the Muslims. The Caliph is viewed as the Vice-regent for Allah on the earth. It is important to understand that when Muslims call for the restoration of the Caliphate, it is ultimately the Mahdi that they are calling for. For the Mahdi is the awaited final Caliph of Islam. As such, Muslims everywhere will be obligated to follow the Mahdi.
- If you see him, go and give him your allegiance, even if you have to crawl over ice, because he is the Vice-regent (*Khalifa*) of Allah, the Mahdi. ¹⁰
- He will pave the way for and establish the government of the family [or community] of Muhammad... Every believer will be obligated to support him. 11

The Army Of Black Flags

- The Mahdi's ascendancy to power is said to be preceded by an army from the east who will be carrying black flags or banners of war. Sheikh Kabbani states:
- Hadith indicate that black flags coming from the area of Khorasan will signify the appearance of the Mahdi is nigh. Khorasan is in todays Iran, and some scholars have said that this hadith means when the black flags appear from Central Asia, i.e. in the direction of Khorasan, then the appearance of the Mahdi is imminent.



The Army Of Black Flags

Another tradition states that:

- The Messenger of Allah said: The black banners will come from the East and their hearts will be as firm as iron. Whoever hears of them should join them and give allegiance, even if it means crawling across snow. 18
- In Islam there are two flags. One is white and one is black. Written across both flags in Arabic are the words, "There is no God but Allah and Muhammad is his Messenger". The white flag is called *Al-Liwaa* and serves as the sign for the leader of the Muslim army and is the flag of the Islamic State. The black flag is called *Ar-Raya* and is used by the Muslim army. It is also called the flag of jihad, and is carried into battle. One flag is governmental and the other is a military flag. ¹⁹ When Muhammad returned to his home city of Mecca after being exiled for eight years, he returned as a conqueror. With him were ten thousand Muslim soldiers. They carried with them black flags. On the flags was one word written in Arabic: *punishment*.





The Conquering Of Israel

- Islamic tradition pictures the Mahdi as joining with the army of Muslim warriors carrying black flags. The Mahdi will then lead this army to Israel and re-conquer it for Islam. The Jews will be slaughtered until very few remain and Jerusalem will become the location of the Mahdi's rule over the Earth.
- [Muhammad] said: "Armies carrying black flags will come from Khurasan. No power will be able to stop them and they will finally reach Eela (Baitul Maqdas in Jerusalem) where they will erect their flags." ²¹
- It is important to note here the reference above to "*Baitul Maqdas*". In Arabic this means "the holy house". This is referring to the Dome of the Rock Mosque and is located on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem.

The Conquering Of Israel

•There is a very famous tradition that is often quoted throughout the Islamic world that speaks of the Mahdi's military campaign against Israel.

The Prophet said... The last hour would not come unless the Muslims will fight against the Jews and the Muslims would kill them until the Jews would hide themselves behind a stone or a tree and a stone or a tree would say: Muslim, or the servant of Allah, there is a Jew behind me; come and kill him

The Miraculous Provider Who Will Be Loved By All

- It is said that the Mahdi will have control over the wind and the rain and the crops. Under the Mahdi's rule, the world will live in prosperity. Islamic tradition relates that Muhammad once said:
- In the last days of my Ummah [universal Islamic community], the Mahdi will appear. Allah will give him power over the wind and the rain and the earth will bring forth its foliage. He will give away wealth profusely, flocks will be in abundance, and the Ummah will be large and honored... ²⁴
- In those years my community will enjoy a time of happiness such as they have never experienced before. Heaven will send rain upon them in torrents, the earth will not withhold any of its plants, and wealth will be available to all. A man will stand and say, "Give to me Mahdi!" and he will say, "Take." ²⁵

The Miraculous Provider Who Will Be Loved By All

- •As a result of the numerous benefits that the Mahdi brings, it is said that all the inhabitants of the Earth will be possessed with a deep love of him:
- •Allah will sow love of him in the hearts of all people. ²⁶
- •Al Mahdi appears, everyone only talks about Him, drinks the love of Him, and never talks about anything other than Him.





The Timing of The Mahdi's Reign

- While there is more than one tradition regarding the nature and timing of the Mahdi's ascendancy to power, there is one particular hadith that places this event at the time of a final peace agreement between the Arabs and the Romans ("Romans" should be interpreted as referring to Christians, or more generally, the West). Although this peace agreement is made with the "Romans", it is said to be mediated specifically through a Jew from the priestly lineage of Aaron. The peace agreement will be made for a period of seven years
- Rasulullah [Muhammad] said: "There will be four peace agreements between you and the Romans [Christians]. The fourth agreement will be mediated through a person who will be from the progeny of Hadrat Haroon [Honorable Aaron Moses' brother] and will be upheld for seven years. (Emphasis mine) 28

The Timing of The Mahdi's Reign

- It appears that the period of this seven year peace agreement will likewise be the period of the Mahdi's reign. While there are a few traditions that specify that the Mahdi will reign on the earth for as much as eight or possibly even nine years, most traditions state that the time of his reign will be seven years.
- The Prophet said... He will divide the property, and will govern the people by the Sunnah of their Prophet and establish Islam on Earth. He will remain seven years, then die, and the Muslims will pray over him.
- The Prophet said: The Mahdi... will fill the earth with equity and justice as it was filled with oppression and tyranny, and he will rule for seven years.

ISLAMIC ESCHATOLOGY Al-Mahdi, The Rider On A White Horse

Ka'b al-Ahbar is supported in his view that this description of the rider on the white horse as found in the Book of Revelation is indeed the Mahdi by two well known Egyptian authors, Muhammad Ibn 'Izzat and Muhammad 'Arif in their book Al Mahdi and the End of Time



Beast of the Earth

Abu Dawud At-Tayalisi recorded from Abu Hurayrah, may Allah be pleased with him, that the Messenger of Allah said...

A beast will emerge from the earth, and with it will be the staff of Musa and the ring of Sulayman, peace be upon them both. It will strike the nose of the disbelievers with the staff, and it will make the face of the believer bright with the ring, until when people gather to eat, they will be able to recognize the believers from the disbelievers.

Beast of the Earth

this was also recorded by Ibn Majah. Ibn Jurayj reported that Ibn Az-Zubayr described the beast and said, "Its head is like the head of a bull, its eyes are like the eyes of a pig, its ears are like the ears of an elephant, its horns are like the horns of a stag, its neck is like the neck of an ostrich, its chest is like the chest of a lion, its color is like the colour of a tiger, its haunches are like the haunches of a cat, its tail is like the tail of a ram, and its legs are like the legs of a camel. Between each pair of its joints is a distance of twelve cubits. It will bring out with it the staff of Musa and the ring of Sulayman. There will be no believer left without it making a white spot on his face, which will spread until all his face is shining white as a result; and there will be no disbeliever left without it making a black spot on his face, which will spread until all his face is black as a result, then when the people trade with one another in the marketplace, they will say, `How much is this, O believer' `How much is this, O disbeliever' And when the members of one household sit down together to eat, they will know who is a believer and who is a disbeliever. Then the beast will say: `O so-and-so, enjoy yourself, for you are among the people of Paradise.' And it will say: `O so-and-so, you are among the people of Hell.' This is what Allah sav

Islamic Jesus

The Subordinate Of The Mahdi

At this time, Jesus descends to meet the army of the Mahdi which will be preparing for battle. It will be just before the time of prayer.

Muslims will still be preparing themselves for the battle drawing up the ranks. Certainly, the time of prayer shall come and then Jesus, son of Mary would descend.

Based on the relevant Hadith, Islamic scholars seem to be in universal agreement that the Mahdi will ask Jesus to lead the prayers. Jesus will then refuse this request and will defer instead to the Mahdi to lead the prayer.

The Messenger of Allah said: A section of my people will not cease fighting for the truth and will prevail until the Day of resurrection. He said: Jesus son of Mary would then descend and their [Muslims'] commander [the Mahdi] would invite him to come and lead them in prayer, but he would say: No, some amongst you are commanders over some.

Islamic Jesus

•Jesus The Faithful Muslim

After Jesus returns, in keeping with his identity as a faithful Muslim, he will perform the ritual pilgrimage to Mecca called *hajj*:

The Prophet said: Verily Isa ibn Maryam shall descend as an equitable judge and fair ruler. He shall tread his path on the way to hajj (pilgrimage) and come to my grave to greet me, and I shall certainly answer him!



Islamic Jesus

Jesus Will Institute Islamic Law

While the Mahdi, as the Caliph (vice-regent) and Imam (leader) of the Muslims is clearly seen as being a superior to Jesus, Jesus is still said to be a leader of the Muslim Community. According to the Islamic traditions, Jesus' primary purpose will be to oversee the institution and the enforcement of the Islamic Shariah law all over the world.

Ibn Qayyim mentioned in *Manar al-munif* that the leader... is the Mahdi who will request Jesus to lead the Muslims in prayer. Jesus will remain on the earth, not as a prophet, but as one of the Community (*ummah*) of Prophet Muhammad. Muslims will follow him as their leader. According to Shalabi, the Mahdi will lead the Muslims in prayer, and Jesus will rule the Muslims according to the Divine Law (Shari'ah). ⁸

Jesus, the son of Mary will descend and will lead them judging amongst them according to the holy Quran and the Sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad.



Islamic Jesus

• Jesus: The Greatest Muslim Evangelist

Islamic tradition teaches that because Jesus will declare himself to be a Muslim, he will lead many Christians to convert to Islam. Regarding those who do not convert to Islam, the Quran states that Jesus will be a witness against them on the Day of Judgment:

There is not one of the People of the Scripture (Christians and Jews) but will believe in him before his death, and on the Day of Resurrection he will be a witness against them. (Surah 4:159)

Islamic Jesus

Jesus Will Abolish Christianity

It is crucial to understand that according to Islamic tradition and belief, when Jesus returns, he does not merely come to convert *most* Christians to Islam but to literally abolish Christianity entirely. This fact is understood when we analyze a very well-known, and oft-quoted tradition that refers to four specific things that Jesus will do when he returns. Jesus is said to:

- 1. Break crosses.
- 2. Kill all swine.
- 3. Abolish the jizyah tax (a Muslim tax on non-Muslims)
- 4. Kill the Muslim antichrist and his followers.

The Prophet said: There is no prophet between me and him, that is, Jesus. He will descent (sic) (to the earth)... He will break the cross, kill swine, and abolish jizyah. Allah will perish all religions except Islam.

Islamic Jesus

Jesus The Slayer Of Jews

Beyond the "accomplishment" of abolishing Christianity on a worldwide scale, another of Jesus' primary jobs is to kill a figure know as the Dajjal, or the Muslim version of the Antichrist. But not only will Jesus kill the Dajjal, but also all of the Dajjal's followers, who consequently, will mostly be Jews.

Jesus: A Good Muslim Family Man

One final aspect of the Muslim Jesus' return must be pointed out. After converting the world to Islam and killing unbelievers, the Dajjal and his followers, Jesus is said to marry, have children and eventually die:

The Prophet said: There is no prophet between me and him, that is, Jesus... He will destroy the Antichrist and will live on the earth for forty years and then he will die. The Muslims will pray over him.

The Islamic Anti-Christ (the Dajjal)

The Prophet was warning us that in the last days there would be someone who would deceive all of humanity. The Dajjal will possess power over this world. Thus, Muslims must be careful not to have the love of the world in their hearts so they won't leave their religion and follow him. He will be able to heal the sick by wiping his hand on them, like Jesus did, but with this deceit the Dajjal will lead people down the path to hell. Thus the Dajjal is the false Messiah, or Anti-Christ (Massih ad-Dajjal). He will pretend to be the Messiah, and deceive people by showing them amazing powers.

The Dajjal Will Claim To Be Jesus Christ And Will Claim To Be Divine

The above tradition shows that the Dajjal's deceptive signs will be for the purpose of leading people into believing that the Dajjal is actually their "lord". Muslim scholars universally have concluded that the Dajjal will claim to be divine. According to the very well known Muslim scholar, Abu Ameenah Bilal Phillips, the Dajjal, "will claim to be God".



THE ANTI-CHRIST

• And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. 5 For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.

KRISHNA VENTA

 Krishna Venta (1911—1958), born Francis Herman Pencovic in San Francisco, founded the WKFL (Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith and Love) Fountain of the World cult in Simi Valley, California in the late 1940s. In 1948 he stated that he was Christ, the new messiah and claimed to have led a convoy of rocket ships to Earth from the extinct planet Neophrates. He died on December 10, 1958 after being suicide bombed by two disgruntled former followers who accused Venta of mishandling cult funds and having been intimate with their wives.



SUN MYUNG MOON

•Sun Myung Moon (1920–2012), believed by members of the Unification Church to be the Messiah and the Second Coming of Christ, fulfilling Jesus' unfinished mission. 
JIM JONES

• Jim Jones (1931–1978), founder of Peoples Temple, which started off as an offshoot of a mainstream protestant sect before becoming a personality cult as time went on. He claimed to be the reincarnation of Jesus, Akhenaten, Buddha, Vladimi r Lenin, and Father Divine in the 1970s. Organized a mass murder suicide at Jonestown, Guyana on November 18, 1978. He shot himself after the murders were done.



YAHWEH BEN YAHWEH

 Yahweh ben Yahweh (1935–2007), born as Hulon Mitchell, Jr., a black nationalist and separatist who created the Nation of Yahweh in 1979 in Liberty City, Florida. His selfproclaimed name means "God, Son of God." He could have only been deeming himself to be "son of God", not God, but many of his followers clearly deem him to be God Incarnate. In 1992, he was convicted of conspiracy to commit murder and sentenced to 18 years in prison.

SUN WORSHIP

 ONE OF THE MOST outstanding examples of how Babylonian paganism has continued to our day may be seen in the way the Romish church invented Mary worship to replace the ancient worship of the mother goddess.

•The story of the mother and child was widely known in ancient Babylon and developed into an established worship. Numerous monuments of Babylon show the goddess mother Semiramis with her child Tammuz in her arms. When the people of Babylon were scattered to the various parts of the earth, they carried the worship of the divine mother and her child with them.

This explains why many nations worshipped a mother and child in one form or another centuries before the true savior, Jesus Christ, was born into this world! In the various countries where this worship spread, the mother and child were called by different names, for, we will recall, language was confused at Babel.

•The Chinese had a mother goddess called **Shingmoo** or the "Holy Mother." She is pictured with child in arms and rays of glory around her head.




 The ancient Germans worshipped the virgin Hertha with child in arms. The Scandinavians called her Disa who was also pictured with a child. The Etruscans called her Nutria, and among the Druids the Virgo-Patitura was worshipped as the "Mother of God." In India, she was known as Indrani, who was also represented with child in arms.

•The mother goddess was known as Aphodite or Ceres to the Greeks; Nana, to the Sumerians; and as Venus or Fortuna to her devotees in the olden days of Rome, and her child as Jupiter. At one time the mother and child were known as Devaki and Crishna. For ages, Isi, the "Great Goddess" and her child Iswara, have been worshipped in India where temples were erected for their worship.

In Asia, the mother was known as Cybele and the child as Deoius. "But regardless of her name or place", says one writer, "she was the wife of Baal, the virgin queen of heaven, who born fruit although she never conceived."

In Egypt, the mother was known as Isis and her child as Horus. It is very common for the religious monuments of Egypt to show the infant Horus seated on the lap of his mother.



 When the children of Israel fell into apostasy, they too were defiled with this mother goddess worship. As we read in Judges 2:13: "They forsook the Lord, and served Baal and Ashtaroth." Ashtaroth or Ashtoreth was the name by which the goddess was known to the children of Israel. It is pitiful to think that those who had known the true God would depart from him and worship the heathen mother.

Yet this is exactly what they did repeatedly (Judges 10:6; 1 Sam. 7:3, 4; 12:10; 1 Kings 11:5; 2 Kings 23:13). One of the titles by which the goddess was known among them was "the queen of heaven" (Jeremiah 44:17-19). The prophet Jeremiah rebuked them for worshipping her, but they rebelled against his warning.

In Ephesus, the great mother was known as Diana. The temple dedicated to her in that city was one of the seven wonders of the ancient world! Not only at Ephesus, but throughout all Asia and the world was the goddess worshipped (Acts 19:27).



This false worship, having spread from Babylon to the various nations, in different names and forms, finally became established at Rome and throughout the Roman Empire. Says a noted writer concerning this period: "The worship of the Great Mother...was ...very popular under the Roman Empire. Inscriptions prove that the two (the mother and the child) received divine honors ... not only in Italy and especially at Rome, but also in the provinces, particularly in Africa, Spain, Portugal, France, Germany, and Bulgaria."

 - •The Babylonian worship of Ishtar, the Golden Egg of Astarte and the fertility rites of spring give us Easter
 - The Calendar year-end on October 31, and its associated occultic rituals, gave us our Halloween
 - This was related to worship of Baal (Mars) and many have been stimulated by the perturbation of the orbit of the earth associated with the planet Mars

•12 "The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast. 13 These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast. 14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful."

THE MEANING OF THE WOMAN AND THE BEAST

•15 Then he said to me, "The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues. 16 And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire. 17 For God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God are fulfilled. 18 And the woman whom you saw is that great city which reigns over the kings of the earth."

REVELATION 17

- •Notice that the prostitute is not the beast, but rides the beast. She initially exploits the beast, but is eventually destroyed by him. (Rev. 17:16-17)
- •The reference to the "golden cup" is another link with Jeremiah, et al.
- Mystery Babylon as a false religious system has been identified with the city of Rome from the early centuries until this present hour.

TEN CLUES

- 1. A prostitute: promiscuous, unfaithful
- 2. Has universal influence; all over the world
- 3. She is seated upon the beast (steers, dominates)
- 4. Purple, Scarlet, Gold, and Jewels
- 5. Golden cup: precious, yet a counterfeit, filled with abominable things
- 6. Mystery, Babylon the Great; linked with Babylon of Nimrod (Cf Rev. 11:8)
- 7. Mother of Prostitutes: has spiritual offspring; Not alone
- 8. Persecutor of Christians, revels in their blood
- 9. Seven Hills, Rome Built on seven hills:
 - The original city of Romulus was built upon Palatine Hill (Latin: Mons Palatinus). The other hills are the Capitoline, Quirinal, Viminal, Esquiline, Caelian, and Aventine (known respectively in Latin as the Mons Capitolinus, Mons Quirinalis, Mons Viminalis, Mons Esquilinus, Mons Caelius, and Mons Aventinus)
- The Great City that rules of the kings of the earth
 - In John's day, could only be Rome.



BABYLON OF 17 = 18

- •1. The usage of the word "Babylon" is never used of the beast or its head (Rev. 17:5,18)
- 2. The context before and after Revelation
 - **C**f. 16:19, 17:1,18; 18:2-3; 19:2
- •3. The statements of Revelation 18:3, 24 with 6:9-11

THE FALL OF BABYLON THE GREAT

 After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated with his glory. ² And he cried mightily with a loud voice, saying, "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a prison for every foul spirit, and a cage for every unclean and hated bird! ³ For all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich through the abundance of her luxury."

THE FALL OF BABYLON THE GREAT

•And I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues. ⁵ For her sins have reached to heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities. ⁶ Render to her just as she rendered to you, and repay her double according to her works; in the cup which she has mixed, mix double for her.

THE FALL OF BABYLON THE GREAT

In the measure that she glorified herself and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; for she says in her heart, 'I sit as queen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.' 8 Therefore her plagues will come in one day—death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong is the Lord God who judges her.

"The kings of the earth who committed fornication and lived luxuriously with her will weep and lament for her, when they see the smoke of her burning, 10 standing at a distance for fear of her torment, saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour your judgment has come.'

•11 "And the merchants of the earth will weep and mourn over her, for no one buys their merchandise anymore: 12 merchandise of gold and silver, precious stones and pearls, fine linen and purple, silk and scarlet, every kind of citron wood, every kind of object of ivory, every kind of object of most precious wood, bronze, iron, and marble;

•13 and cinnamon and incense, fragrant oil and frankincense, wine and oil, fine flour and wheat, cattle and sheep, horses and chariots, and bodies and souls of men. 14 The fruit that your soul longed for has gone from you, and all the things which are rich and splendid have gone from you, and you shall find them no more at all.

•15 The merchants of these things, who became rich by her, will stand at a distance for fear of her torment, weeping and wailing, 16 and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city that was clothed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls! 17 For in one hour such great riches came to nothing.' Every shipmaster, all who travel by ship, sailors, and as many as trade on the sea, stood at a distance 18 and cried out when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, 'What is like this great city?'

- •19 "They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had ships on the sea became rich by her wealth! For in one hour she is made desolate.'
- •20 "Rejoice over her, O heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets, for God has avenged you on her!"

FINALITY OF BABYLON'S FALL

•21 Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying, "Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore. ²² The sound of harpists, musicians, flutists, and trumpeters shall not be heard in you anymore. No craftsman of any craft shall be found in you anymore, and the sound of a millstone shall not be heard in you anymore.

FINALITY OF BABYLON'S FALL

23 The light of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore. For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery all the nations were deceived.²⁴ And in her was found the **blood of prophets and saints**, and of all who were slain on the earth."

THE ORIGIN OF BABYLON

- The first world dictator: Nimrod ("Rebel")
 - "a mighty hunter in defiance of the Lord." Gen. 10:9
 - •Babel = (as well as "Babylon") means "gateway to the gods" or "gate of the gods" in the local Mesopotamian languages. In Hebrew the word babel is related to balal, meaning "to confuse."
- This was the beginning of the city of Babylon
 - This ziggurat was later rebuilt by Nebuchadnezzar as Etemenanki, "the building which is the foundation of heaven and earth"
 - The Letter to Cyrus
 - When Cyrus make his grand entrance Daniel presented him with an ancient scroll of Isaiah, which contained a personal letter addressing him by name (Josephus, Antiquities, XI, 12)
 - Isaiah had died 150 years before Cyrus was born! (Isa. 45:1-5)

Zech 14

Both the beast and his false prophet were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur. 21 Their entire army was killed by the sharp sword that came from the mouth of the one riding the white horse. And the vultures all gorged themselves on the dead bodies.

Satan Locked Up

Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.



Christ Builds a Temple

Zech 6

•12 Tell him, 'This is what the LORD of Heaven's Armies says: Here is the man called the Branch. He will branch out from where he is and build the Temple of the LORD. ¹³ Yes, he will build the Temple of the LORD. Then he will receive royal honor and will rule as king from his throne. He will also serve as priest from his throne, [e] and there will be perfect harmony between his two roles.'

HELL - WHAT IS HELL?

- 41 "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: (Matthew 25:15)
- ² And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, Some to everlasting life, Some to shame and everlasting contempt. (Daniel 12:2)
- ¹⁰ The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the **lake of fire** and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
- ¹⁵ And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire. (Rev. 20:10, 5)
- Hell is a place prepared for the devil, his angels, the beast, false prophets and those who's name are not in the Book of Life.

WHERE IS HELL?

Various theories on the location of hell have been put forward. A traditional view is that hell is in the center of the earth (Luke 15:10, Ephesian 4:9). Others propose that hell is located in outer space in a black hole. In the Old Testament, the word translated "hell" is Sheol; in the New Testament, it's Hades (meaning "unseen") and Gehenna ("the Valley of Hinnom"). Sheol is also translated as "pit" and "grave." Both Sheol and Hades refer to a temporary abode of the dead before judgment (Psalm 9:17; Revelation 1:18). Gehenna refers to an eternal state of punishment for the wicked dead (Mark 9:43).

WHERE IS HELL (LAKE OF FIRE)?

- ⁴⁰ For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. (Matthew 12:40)
- Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? (Ephesians 4:9)
- Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. (Revelation 14:9-10)

HOW LONG IS HELL (LAKE OF FIRE)?

- Some believe it will be for a short time
- Others believe it will be eternal



HOW LONG IS HELL (LAKE OF FIRE)? — SHORT TIME

- The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should **perish** but that all should come to repentance. (2 Peter 3:9)
- 46 And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."
 (Matthew 25:46)
- The punishment itself is not eternal, but the results are.
- ⁷ as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. (Jude 1:7)
- 6 and turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, condemned *them* to destruction, making *them* an example to those who afterward would live ungodly; (2 Peter 2:6)
- But the wicked shall perish; And the enemies of the LORD, Like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away. (Psalm 37:20)
- ⁶ then his master shall bring him to the judges. He shall also bring him to the door, or to the doorpost, and his master shall pierce his ear with an awl; and he shall serve him forever. (Exodus 21:6)
- ²² But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, "Not until the child is weaned; then I will take him, that he may appear before the LORD and remain there forever." (1 Samuel 1:22)

HOW LONG IS HELL (LAKE OF FIRE)? — ETERNAL

- 8 "If your hand or foot causes you to sin, cut it off and cast *it* from you. It is better for you to enter into life lame or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet, to be cast into the everlasting fire. (Matthew 18:8)
- ²⁴ "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life. (**John 5:24**)
- ⁹ These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, (2 Thessalonians. 1:9)
- ¹¹ And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." (Revelation 14:11)
- ¹⁷ His winnowing fan *is* in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather the wheat into His barn; but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire." (Luke 3:17 or Matt. 3:12)

IS HELL ETERNAL?

- •Yes, it is.
- •Why will God go through great lengths to get us save if at the end, the unsaved will be gone in a second.
- •16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have **everlasting**life. ¹⁷ For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. (John 3:16-17)



HEAVEN

•"Dear friends, now we are children of God and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when He appears, we shall be like Him." (1 John 3:2)

- •When we enter heaven will be changed physically and spiritually. John tells us we will be like Jesus.
- •What will that be like?




WE WILL NO LONGER SIN

- "He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ." (Phil 1:6)
- In heaven Jesus will remove our sinful nature and complete making us new creations. Imagine you have a computer program that has problems (Ha! Not too hard to imagine that, is it). But then the new version comes out and everything that is good about the program is left in but everything bad is fixed and not only that, but many great new features are added. That's what we will be like in heaven.



WE WILL NOT BE SUBJECT TO THE SAME LAWS OF PHYSICS

In **John 20:19, 26** we find Jesus walking through walls and locked doors to reach the disciples. Elsewhere in the Bible we read about angels that appear and disappear. We will be able to travel anywhere instantly.





WE WILL STILL EAT AND TOUCH

•We will be able to walk through solid objects and still be able to touch and eat like Jesus did in John 20:27 and John 21:10-15. Paul tells us that "flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of heaven" (1 Cor. 15:59), so eating will be done for pleasure and not necessity And Revelation 22:2 tells us that in heaven there will be a tree of life that bears twelve different kinds of fruit each month. Some think that there may be a feast each month when this tree blooms and a time of great fellowship as we gather around to share a meal together.

WE WILL STILL EAT AND TOUCH — ISAIAH 65

- •17 "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.
- •21 They shall build houses and inhabit *them;* They shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit.



WE WILL NEVER BE SICK AGAIN


• We currently live in a fallen, imperfect world. People get sick, suffer and die. In heaven that won't be true. God tells us in heaven there will "no longer be any curse" (Rev. 22:3). What does that mean? Revelation 21:4 tells us: "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." Heaven will be a world where, "the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. And the lame will leap like a deer, and the mute tongue will shout for joy" (Isaiah 35:5-6). 
WE WILL RECOGNIZE ONE ANOTHER

- •You can read Matthew 17:3 for a little insight here. Moses and Elijah appear and talk with Jesus. Peter recognizes both of them even though they both lived many years before him.
- In heaven, we will know not only our loved ones but everyone else that is there!



WE WILL HAVE DEEPER RELATIONSHIPS

- There will be no marriage in heaven (Matthew 22:30). The reason is that relationships will be much deeper than anything on earth. Remember that we'll be free from sin.
- Relationships will be pure and free of doubt, jealousy and gossip. Love, joy and peace in heaven we will experience these things the way they were meant to be. We can only experience these things partly now. While it's true we love and have joy and peace on earth, we don't fully experience them because we also know what it is to hate, grieve, and have trouble. In heaven, when these things are removed, we will love and rejoice and be at peace completely.





THE NEW HEAVEN AND NEW EARTH

"Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and earth passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the Throne saying, 'Now the dwelling of God is with men, and He will live with them. They will be his people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.' He who was seated on the Throne said, 'I am making everything new!" - Revelation 21:1-4

THE NEW JERUSALEM

- Revelation 21:2-3 tells us we will have a new home called "New Jerusalem". Jerusalem means, "city of peace". This New Jerusalem is massive! It will be about 1,500 miles wide, 1,500 miles long, and 1,500 miles high. (Revelation 21:15-16). That would make this huge city roughly the size of the moon. The city will have 12 gates with the names of the twelve tribes of Israel written on them. The foundation will be twelve layers to it with the names of the twelve apostles written on them. (Revelation 21:12-17)
- And the entire city will be made of gold and jewels. The walls will be made of pure diamond and the city of pure gold clear as glass (Revelation 21:18). The foundation will be filled with precious stones (Revelation 21:19-21).



WE WILL BE WITH CHRIST

- More important than anything else is the fact that we will be with our Lord forever. From His throne flows the River of Life. It will be perfect, clear as crystal. And we will see Him face to face (Revelation 22:4).
- We will be able to talk to Him, ask Him questions, and listen to Him speak. Imagine hearing His voice the Bible says it will be "like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder (Revelation 14:2). Imagine the stories He'll tell, the lessons He'll teach, and the love He'll share.
